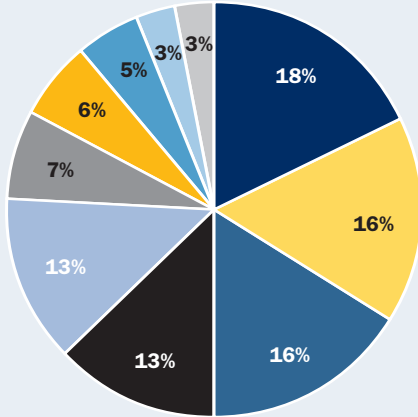

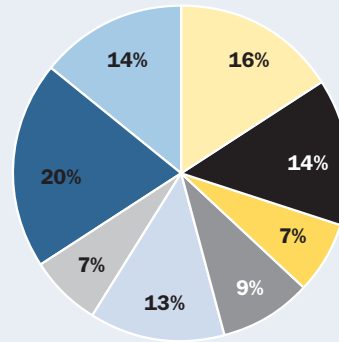

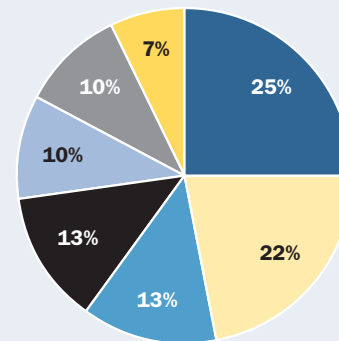

Program Options — Spring or Fall

Fall Schedule: Those starting in fall attend classes for three quarters each year, excluding summers, and complete the program in 33 months. During the first two years, students attend two three-hour classes per week – one weeknight and one Saturday.

Spring Schedule: Those starting in spring attend classes for nine consecutive quarters, including summers, to complete their degree in 27 months. During the first year and a half, they attend two three-hour classes per week, on weeknights.

In the last three quarters of both program options, the schedule is determined by electives, offered Monday - Thursday evenings and Saturdays.
