He serves as the Foundation's lead observer of domestic policy issues, working to translate policy trends and position program strategies in affordable housing, community change, mental health, juvenile justice, education, and urban and regional policy within the larger context of local, state and national policy developments.

Michael served previously as Assistant Secretary for Policy Development and Research in HUD during the Clinton years. He also served on the faculty at the University of North Carolina - Chapel Hill, where he was the MacRae Professor of Public Policy, Planning, and Business. He is the author of *State and Local Affordable Housing Programs: A Rich Tapestry*, and is one of the leading authorities today on affordable housing issues and policy.
