ELIGIBILITY

2. Enroll in and Successfully complete the capstone course, FEMBA 246F Seminar in the Management of the Real Estate Enterprise (Ideally taken after the remaining eligible courses.
3. Enroll in and successfully complete 2 or more of the electives listed below
